1. I am the Chief Engineer /Coal & Commercial, Telangana State Power Generation Corporation Ltd, Corporate office, Vidyuth soudha, Hyderabad and also authorized signatory of petitioner herein and as such I am well acquainted with the facts of the case. I am authorized to file this petition on behalf of the applicant herein.
2. It is to submit that, there is a delay in filing Mutli Year Tariff application for Determination of capital cost for new stations and Generation Tariff for the existing and new stations for the control period (2019-24), due to the below mentioned reasons:
  - a. In preparation of MYT for the control period (2019-24) and True up for the control period (2014-19), Audited Annual Accounts for the FY 2018 – 19 are essential for deriving Capitalization, Gross Fixed Assets which are the basic data for computing ROE, Int. on Loans etc.
  - b. The final comments from C&AG Audit received on 26<sup>th</sup> September 2019 & TSGENCO 5<sup>th</sup> Annual General Body Meeting of the company was conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2019 and adopted the Annual Accounts.
  - c. Tariff preparation involves the process of coordinating with all the wings in the organization, compilation of voluminous information. TSGENCO commenced the preparation of the MYT for FY 2019 – 24 & True up for the control period FY 2014-19 after completion of Audited Annual Accounts for the FY 2018-19, collecting data from all the field units and consolidation activities, involving 7 Nos. Thermal, 8 Nos. Hydel stations, 4 Nos. Small Hydel stations & a Mini Hydel Station.
  - d. **Employees Bifurcation:**  
Consequent to the orders of One Man Committee under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Justice Sri.Dharmadhikari Dt.26.12.2019, new incumbents assumed charge in place of the existing Senior Officers resulted in certain delay in collection and preparation of data.

e. **COVID – 19 outbreak:**

Meantime, there was an outbreak of COVID – 19 and the declaration of lockdown by the Central Government for 21 days w.e.f 24th March, 2020 to stop the spread of this pandemic. Government of India further extended

lockdown period beyond the initial period of 21 days till 31.5.2020 and the lifting of lockdown has started in a phased manner only from 01.06.2020.

- ii. Some officers of the organization were affected with COVID and few lost their lives fighting the COVID.
  - iii. Due to COVID-19 pandemic the receipt of relevant information from all existing generating stations & new projects , consolidation and preparation of True up filings 2014-19, MYT filings 2019-24 in prescribed formats has been delayed and there was a difficulty in physical access to the voluminous records and compile the required information from its lenders etc
- f. Further, it is pertinent to submit that, Keeping in the unprecedented measures taken by the Government of India to contain the spread of COVID – 19 pandemic and the difficulties being faced by the Generating Companies in preparation and filing of petitions, Hon'ble CERC has granted extension of time till **30.06.2020** vide **Suo Motu Petition No.7/SM/2020** in order Dated 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2020 and further extended to **30.09.2020** vide **Interlocutory Application Nos. 39/IA/2020 & 40/IA/2020 in Suo Motu Petition No.7/SM/2020** in order Dated 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2020.

Hence, TSGENCO humbly requests the Hon'ble Commission to condone the delay in filing the Multi Year Tariff application for the control period (2019-24).

### 3. Payment of Application Fee:-

The Applicant has submitted the Bankers cheque No.326201 dt.27.01.2021, SBI, Vidyut Soudha Branch, Hyderabad for Rs 25000/- towards fee for filing of interlocutory application for condonation of delay in filing Mutli Year Tariff application of TSGENCO existing and new stations for the control period (2019-24).



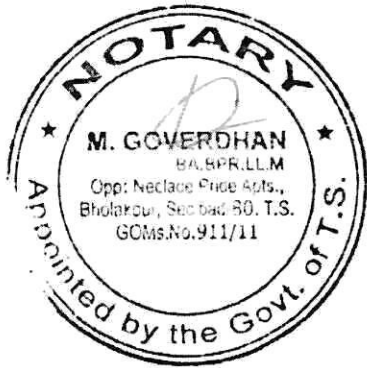

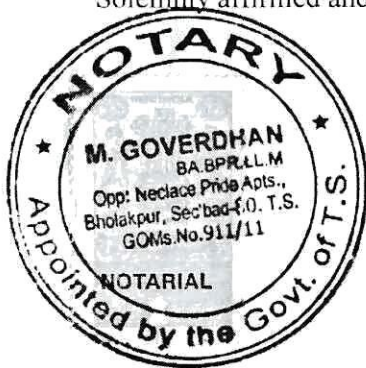
