Status in respect of relinquishment of power allocation from Ramagundam STPS Stage I & II and Neyveli TPS Stage – I & II.

- Hon'ble TSERC while issuing consent for relinquishment of power allocation from Ramagundam STPS Stage I & II (358.37 MW) and Neyveli TPS Stage – I & II (165 MW) as per the guidelines issued in MoP notification dated 22.03.2021 envisaged three scenarios and requested to apprise the Commission of correspondence with NTPC/NLC in the subject matter from time to time.
- As per the minutes of the 39th SRPC meeting dated 03.01.2022, in the case of Ramagundam STPS Stage I & II, LTA (PoC) Charges have been exempted for Telangana State for the quantum of its share as TSTRANSCO system is capable of evacuating Telangana Share.
- The issue of relinquishment of power allocation from Ramagundam STPS Stage I & II (358.37 MW) was placed in the TSPCC meeting held on 18.02.2022. TSPCC decided to retain the TSDISCOMs share of 358.37 MW of Power from NTPC Ramagundam STPS Stage I & II as the evacuation of power is through STU and PoC charges are exempted for Telangana State and TSDISCOMs did not issue any notice to NTPC for relinquishment of TS share from RSTPS-I&II.
- Regarding, relinquishment of power allocation from Neyveli TPS Stage – I & II (165 MW), a notice was issued to M/s. NLC India Limited vide letter dated 15.12.2021 informing that TSDISCOMs are willing to relinquish their share of 165 MW of Power from Neyveli TPS Stage-I & II as per the guidelines issued in MoP notification dated 22.03.2021 and TSDISCOMs will exit from the PPA after 6 months of this notice as per the MoP guidelines.
- Meanwhile, MoP has reallocated TS share of 149.27 MW (Firm allocation) from NLC TPS-II Stage I & II to Tamilnadu with immediate effect from 28.03.2022.
- MoP has retained balance share of 15.76 MW (unallocated share of TS) to TSDISCOMs, even though TSDISCOMs had relinquished entire share of 165 MW (Firm allocated 149.27 MW + unallocated 15.67 MW).
- The Secretary to Govt, of India, MoP was addressed vide letter dated 26.05.2022 informing that retaining unallocated share of 15.76 MW by TSDISCOMs is not as per the Regulations when the allotted share is zero. Hence, the same may be considered as relinquished.
- But, MoP is still scheduling the unallocated share of 15.76 MW from NLC TPS-II Stage I & II to TSDISCOMs.
