This petition came up for hearing on 28.01.2021. Sri. Abhishek Manot, Advocate representing J. Sagar Associates for the petitioner has appeared through virtual hearing on 28.01.2021. The petition having been heard and having stood over for consideration to this day, the Commission passed the following:

ORDER

The petitioner had filed the petition under section 63 of the Electricity Act, 2003, seeking the following prayer.

i) "To adopt the tariff of Rs. 4.543 / kWh for supply of 5 MW RTC Power and the tariff of Rs. 4.789 / kWh for supply of 5 MW power from 08:00 to 23:00 (on weekdays i.e. Monday to Friday) hours for a period of one year as and when the power distribution licensee operations starts, discovered through e-bidding process in accordance with the

'guidelines for short-term (i.e., for a period less than or equal to one year) procurement of power by distribution licensees through tariff based bidding process' issued by Ministry of Power, Government of India, on March 30, 2016.

- ii) To approve the PPA signed between the petitioner and M/s SembCorp Gayatri Power Limited under Section 86 (1) (b) of the Electricity Act, 2003.
- iii) Permit the petitioner herein for any inadvertent omissions, errors, short coming and permit the petitioner to add / change / modify / alter this filing and make further submissions as may be required at a future date.
- 2. The petitioner has also filed an interlocutory application, seeking the following prayer:
 - i) To condone the inadvertent delay of 83 days in submission of the petition for adoption for tariff discovered through e-bidding process.
 - ii) To condone any inadvertent omissions, errors, short coming and permit the petitioner to add / change / modify / alter this filing and make further submissions as may be required at a future date.
- 3. During the course of hearing the counsel for the petitioner stated that the relief sought in this petition does not survive as the PPA is with reference to the particular year only and no action is required now in this petition, as such he may be permitted to withdraw the same. Permission is accorded for withdrawal of the petition.
- 4. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn, but without costs. Consequently, the pending interlocutory application is closed.
